As Assistant Chief of Staff for Operations, NATO Joint Force Command, he managed southern NATO force deployments, exercises, training, and equipping, working with NATO member country military leaders and key U.S. Navy and Joint service enablers. His command assignments included Carrier Strike Group 12, the aircraft carrier USS Carl Vinson (CVN 70), two amphibious ships, and a Hornet squadron. Over his Navy career, he accumulated 3,500 A-7 and F/A-18 flight hours, and served more than nine years at sea. He is a graduate of the Navy Nuclear Power School.
