He also led advancement of next-generation reactor demonstrations and reactor technology risk reduction programs, as well as used nuclear fuel interim storage, disposition, and recycling initiatives.

Prior to joining the U.S. DOE, Mr. Griffith served in the U.S. nuclear submarine force. He continued serving in the U.S. Navy Reserve throughout his DOE service, retiring at the rank of Captain, and is Submarine and Engineering Department Head Qualified.
