Earlier, as Deputy Joint PEO for Chemical and Biological Defense, General Abramson led a \$2.6B annual budget and oversaw operations across DoD, the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), and allied partners. As Military Assistant to the Under Secretary of the Army, he advised on system acquisition, contracting, and modernization.
